Some current projects underway:

- 1. The community entrance trees have been beautifully decorated with lights for the entire community to enjoy.
- 2. Painting of the clubhouse and entrance walls is underway and should be complete by the 15th of December, weather permitting. The painters have been sealing and repairing cracks in the concrete blocks and walls before painting. This will help our walls stay strong long term, and save the community money.

- 4. Oak trees will be lifted 2-3 feet around the roadsides in the community to clear both walking and driving lanes on all community roads.

- 6. Final funds from Pulte should be received soon. The community should thank Scott from Beacon for connecting us with the attorney that finally made it happen.
